A Simple Way to Use Any Daily Devotional

1. **Read the Scripture passage slowly.**
2. **Read the devotional reflection.**
3. **Ask:**
 - What is God teaching me?
 - What needs to change in my life?
 - How can I live this truth today?
4. **Write one sentence of application.**
5. **Pray about what you learned.**

A devotional is most effective when it moves from **information** → **reflection** → **prayer** → **daily action**.
