Once your application has been received and processed, we will assist you in preparing for your time with us, providing as much information as we can about the upcoming project/s for your group.

Each Mission Experience is uniquely different, and all projects are scheduled according to the unique set of gifts and graces your team possess. The project list will change week-to-week based in many factors, such as; weather, prior team's work completion, need of the community, etc.

We will do our utmost to keep you informed if any changes occur and ask that team flexibility be your teams #1 gift to all. Days may not go as planned and the team at **The28th.Life** will do everything possible to anticipate, adapt and assist you in the same when changes occur.

There is always a need for highly skilled tradespeople, but we have found that every volunteer has a unique set of talents and we will work side-by-side with you to expose, encourage and build those skills so please be encouraged about your upcoming time with us. There is always something you can do here with **The28th.Life!**

WHO SHOULD APPLY

The28th.Life welcomes both youth and adults. We accept your fellowship groups, young. adults and adult groups, ecumenical groups and secular groups.

YOUTH GROUP LEADERS

For youth groups we ask that you do your best to have trained youth leaders to meet the criteria for youth. Teams below but understand that this is not always possible. Do not worry as we will do everything we can to accommodate your team.

The Leaders along with a designated youth team member will meet with The28th.Life staff to schedule assignment, plan the work and discuss the needs to complete the project. Choose your leaders in this area carefully. If you are doing construction or another special project, you will need to bring people who have experience in those areas to supervise your group. For those activities the minute-by-minute supervision needs to come from your leaders. For construction projects, usually some experience in home repair will be adequate. The leader does not have to be a professional.

HOW LONG CAN YOU STAY?

There is work for teams who come for one day, a weekend, several days, or an entire week! During the summer, teams start on Sunday afternoon (with their arrival) and end Saturday morning.

The28th.Life welcomes teams during the spring, summer and fall and with some additional planning can welcome winter teams.

The normal schedule will consist of four days of work and one day touring the area. Work hours will be scheduled by your group leaders to include one hour for lunch. We require groups to be in by 5:30pm or make

other arrangements with The28th.Life staff. Remember our staff cannot leave until all groups are checked in and accounted for.

SPIRITUAL GROWTH

Each morning, following breakfast, clean-up and before we begin the work of the day, we will meet for a time of devotion and prayer. Every group will be asked to assist during this time. We suggest that each group also plan a brief daily “debriefing” time allowing its team members to share their daily experiences with each other, enriching their spiritual lives.

Holy Communion will be served during your week with us also, and you may be asked to assist in this time together.

LODGING & FOOD

Please plan on being here before 6:00 pm unless prior arrangements have been made. We will assist you in planning if necessary. When you arrive, our staff will meet with you. All groups may stay at the Mission/Event Center or motels or if you have an RV, we have accommodations for hookup. If staying at the Center, you will need to bring bedding for college dorm beds, which take a long size sheet and showers are available.

FOOD

You are responsible for your own food. We have a kitchen for your use, located in the Mission/Event Center. You can cook, eat out, or any combination of the two. As part of your application fees paper products— i.e., paper plates, napkins, plastic ware, toilet tissue, Kleenex, garbage bags, cleaning supplies, etc., will be provided.

We ask that if you would like to assist us further by donating in this area, please speak with us to make that happen, providing items that are different from what is currently being used could create an issue with dispensers, storage, etc.

Pasty’s are available for purchase during your time with us. If you would like to have them for a meal during your time with us, please contact us ahead of your arrival to make the necessary arrangements. If wanting to have them available to travel home with you, please let us know upon your arrival the quantity you would like and make sure to bring a cooler large enough to accommodate your request.

LAUNDRY

Washers and dryers are currently unavailable at the Center but there are laundromats in the area if needed.

Transportation

Each group is responsible for providing transportation to the job site. Also, please try to arrive between 5:00pm and 6:00pm on your scheduled date of arrival. If you are unable to be here at this time, please notify us of your estimated time of arrival.

If you are delayed or have decided to stop at one of the many tourist attractions/parks along the way and will not be arriving within an hour of your estimated time of arrival, please call ahead to let us know. Contact information will be provided to each team.

COST

I recognize the participation in the short-term mission trip and its activities may be hazardous and dangerous, and I willingly assume all risks associated with the short-term mission trip.

I acknowledge that I have been advised to seek my medical professional to understand the potential for contracting disease or parasites or suffering other adverse health consequences during my participation in the short-term. I understand that such diseases, parasites or health conditions may cause or result in serious health problems and may be fatal. I also realize that I will be serving in an area affected by natural disaster, one that may report cases of diseases more frequently than in the United States such as, Hepatitis A Hepatitis B and/or other diseases or illnesses.

I am aware that **The28th.Life**, strongly advises me to obtain Tetanus Vaccinations and any other vaccinations, inoculations, or immunizations recommended by the Center for Disease Control or federal or applicable state health authorities. After careful consideration of these risks, I have either received all recommended vaccinations, inoculations, or immunizations from medical professionals or I have declined to receive them due to my religious beliefs, personal convictions, or medical contradictions. I agree that my decision to decline receipt of any or all of the recommended precautionary measures increase my risk of contracting disease and suffering other potential adverse consequence.

I acknowledge and understand that I have agreed to travel into an area affected by a natural disaster to preform cleanup and/or construction work designed to repair or replace homes. I understand that this work entails a risk of physical injury and often involves hard physical labor, heavy lifting and other strenuous activity; and that some activities may take place on ladders and building framing other than ground level. I certify that I am in good health and physically able to preform this type of work.

I acknowledge and understand that I am engaging in this short-term mission trip, travel, projects and other activities that are associated. I acknowledge and understand that this is a "grass roots" activity to support individuals adversely affected by Hurricane/Flood/Tornado or other disaster OR are receiving assistance to repair or replace substandard housing.

Therefore, in consideration of the privilege to participate extended to me by **The28th.Life**, and on behalf of myself, executors, administrators, successors and assigns, I do hereby waive, release and forever discharge **The28th.Life**, employees, directors, officers, agents, representatives, and volunteers, from any and all actions, omissions, causes claims and/or damages arising from, relating to, or resulting from my participation in the mission trip, including but not limited to, injury, expense, cost, damage, loss, illness, or death.
