Module Overview

Revival spread because ordinary Christians understood they were missionaries wherever they lived.

As followers of Jesus, we are called to live intentionally.

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LESSON 29 — SEEING YOUR MISSION FIELD

Theme

God has already placed you exactly where He wants to use you.

Key Scriptures

- Matthew 5:13–16

 - Jeremiah 29:7

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Big Idea

Your everyday life is your mission field.

Introduction

Many people believe serving God requires going somewhere else.

Jesus often sends us exactly where we already are.

God has uniquely placed you among people who may never enter a church building.

Your coworkers.

Your classmates.

Your neighbors.

Your family.

Your friends.

These aren't accidents.

They're assignments.

God has positioned you to be His light in places no one else can reach.

Mission begins by noticing the people around us and asking God to help us see them through His eyes.

Living Missionally

Each day ask yourself:

- Who needs encouragement today?
- Who seems lonely?
- Who needs hope?
- Who could benefit from prayer?
- Where is God already at work around me?

Mission begins with awareness.

Reflection

1. Who has God placed in your everyday life?
 2. Which relationships might become opportunities for the Gospel?
 3. How can you intentionally love your community this week?
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Weekly Challenge

Walk through your neighborhood, workplace, or school praying silently for the people around you.

Ask God to help you see your community as He sees it.

Father,

Open my eyes to the people You've placed around me. Help me recognize every opportunity to represent Jesus with love, kindness, and truth.

LESSON 30 — FAITH IN ACTION

Theme

Our faith becomes most visible when it is lived consistently.

Key Scriptures

- James 2:14–18
 - Micah 6:8
 - Galatians 5:13
 - Titus 3:8
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Big Idea

The Gospel is both proclaimed and demonstrated.

Introduction

People often notice our actions before they hear our words.

A life marked by kindness...

Generosity...

Integrity...

Forgiveness...

Compassion...

Creates opportunities for conversations about Jesus.

Faith is never meant to remain private.

It becomes visible through everyday obedience.

Small acts of faithfulness often become powerful testimonies of God's love.

Everyday Mission

Live your faith by:

- Serving without recognition.
- Forgiving quickly.
- Encouraging generously.
- Giving sacrificially.
- Speaking truth with love.
- Loving people consistently.

Your everyday life is often your greatest sermon.

Reflection

1. Does your daily life reflect your faith?
 2. What opportunities do you have to demonstrate Christ's love?
 3. What small act of obedience could God be asking of you today?
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Weekly Challenge

Choose one intentional act of kindness every day this week.

Look for opportunities to serve without expecting anything in return.

Help my life reflect the love of Jesus in every conversation, every decision, and every opportunity You place before me.

LESSON 31 — MAKING EVERYDAY DISCIPLES

Theme

Discipleship is not an event—it is a lifestyle.

Key Scriptures

- Matthew 28:18–20
 - 2 Timothy 2:2
 - Luke 9:23
 - Acts 2:42–47
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Big Idea

Every believer is called to help someone else follow Jesus.

Introduction

Making disciples doesn't always happen in classrooms.

It happens around dinner tables.

Coffee shops.

Workplaces.

Homes.

Neighborhoods.

Life-on-life.

Jesus disciplined people while walking roads, sharing meals, serving others, and living everyday life with them.

You can do the same.

Invite someone to read Scripture.

Pray together.

Share what God is teaching you.

Serve alongside one another.

Encourage one another toward Christ.

Discipleship happens one relationship at a time.

Becoming a Disciple-Maker

Ask God:

- Who needs encouragement?
- Who wants to grow spiritually?
- Who could I invite into my daily life?
- Who might one day disciple someone else?

Healthy disciples naturally multiply.

Reflection

1. Who has invested in your faith?
 2. Who is God inviting you to invest in?
 3. What simple next step could begin that relationship?
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Weekly Challenge

Invite one person to regularly read Scripture, pray, or meet with you over the next month.

Simply begin walking together.

Help me faithfully invest in others just as others have invested in me. Use my life to help people know, love, and follow Jesus.

LESSON 32 — PREPARING FOR THE UNLEASHING

Theme

God has been preparing you for a life of multiplication and Kingdom impact.

Key Scriptures

- Acts 13:1–3

 - Ephesians 3:20–21
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Big Idea

Preparation always precedes deployment.

Introduction
