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LESSON 29 — LIVING THE GREAT COMMISSION

Theme

The Great Commission is the mission of every believer.

Key Scriptures

- Matthew 28:18–20

 - Isaiah 6:8
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Big Idea

Every Christian is called to make disciples.

Introduction

The Great Commission is not reserved for pastors, missionaries, or ministry leaders.

It belongs to every follower of Jesus.

Some are called across the street.

Others across the world.

But every believer is called to intentionally point people toward Christ.

Your mission field begins wherever God has placed you.

Your home.

Your workplace.

Your neighborhood.

Your school.

Your community.

Your daily routines.

The question is not whether God has sent you.

The question is whether you recognize where He has already sent you.

Living Missionally

Live each day asking:

- Who needs encouragement?
- Who needs hope?
- Who needs prayer?
- Who needs to experience God's love today?
- Where is God already working?
- How can I join Him?

Mission begins with availability.

Reflection

2. Who needs to hear about Jesus through your life?
3. How can you intentionally live on mission this week?

Pray every morning:

"Lord, show me one person You want me to love today."

Then faithfully respond.

LESSON 30 — PERSEVERING IN THE JOURNEY

Theme

Faithfulness is measured over a lifetime.

Key Scriptures

- Hebrews 12:1–3
 - James 1:2–4
 - Galatians 6:9
 - Philippians 3:12–14
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Big Idea

God calls us to remain faithful through every season.

Introduction

Every disciple experiences mountaintops and valleys.

There will be seasons of joy.

Seasons of waiting.

Theme

Faithful disciples leave behind faithful disciples.

Key Scriptures

- 2 Timothy 2:2

 - Colossians 1:28–29
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Big Idea

The Gospel advances through faithful multiplication.

Introduction

The greatest measure of your ministry will not be attendance.

Or recognition.

Or accomplishments.

It will be lives transformed.

People disciplined.

Theme

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Big Idea

You have been sent to carry Christ's light into the world.
